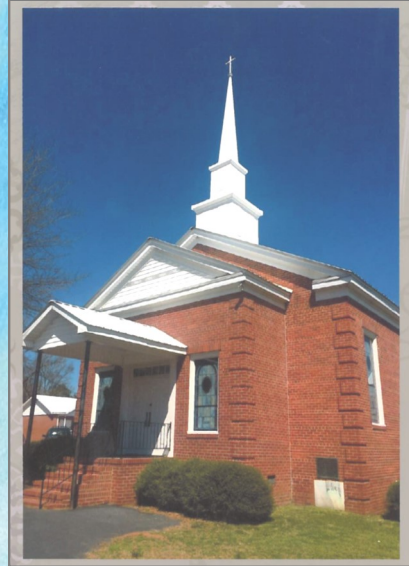


Camp Good Grief
